EXCELLENT RESULTS FOR DOOR SUPERVISORS

Yeovil College Door Supervisor students have achieved excellent results which far exceeds the national average. The College's annual result for the British Institute of Innkeepers Awarding Body (BIAB) National Certificate for Door Supervisors is 100% pass rate against the national average of 96%.

Yeovil College has been running the two-day Door Supervisors qualification since 2004 when it became an offence to operate as a Door Supervisor without an SIA (Security Industry Authority) License to Practice. The qualification consists of two units: Roles & Responsibilities for Door Supervisors and Conflict Management for Door Supervisors and each of the units are assessed by multiple-choice examination questions. The units cover areas such as how to deal with incidents, admission policies and procedures, how to resolve conflict and how to learn from conflict.

Brian Doidge, Curriculum Quality Manager (Higher Education and Adult) Faculty of Business and Hospitality said ***"We are obviously delighted with these results, which is tribute both to the hard work of our students and the high quality of the teaching."***
