This week saw the launch of an exciting new resource, which will allow potential Yeovil College students to apply for full-time courses online, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

For the first time, visitors to www.yeovil.ac.uk will also be able to complete and submit full-time application forms online. 2009 saw Yeovil College's biggest year for applications and it is hoped that the new online form will be easier for applicants to complete and send to the College, speeding up the application process and making sure that applicants have the best chance of getting onto their chosen courses. Many courses were greatly in demand last year, so interested students should apply as soon as possible, to ensure they can arrange an interview quickly.

Other new resources have also been added to the website, including virtual and video tours of the College's main Mudford Road campus and the Construction Skills Centre at Lufton. An e-version of the new full-time prospectus for 14-19 students is also available, allowing people to access information on A Levels, vocational courses, apprenticeships and the new Diplomas in a more environmentally friendly way.

This is just one part of an ongoing programme of review and improvement for the College website. It is aimed at enhancing access to information for potential students everywhere and changes have already led to the College being highly commended at last year's Further Education First awards, the College Marketing Network's awards for celebrating best practice and imaginative and excellent work by UK Further Education colleges.

Andy Perlejewski, Director of the 14-19 Curriculum, said *"It is very important for anyone interested in going to college to find out as much as possible about the courses and institution before they apply at any time. These online resources will ensure that potential students have significantly better access to information about us and allow them to make informed decisions at an earlier stage. Our Customer Liaison and Enrolment Team will be on hand to support the process as usual and applicants can also opt for the more traditional paper-based application or call the Team on 01935 423921 for more support."*
