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## **CELEBRATE BURNS NIGHT AT THE DA VINCI RESTAURANT!**

On Monday 25<sup>th</sup> January 2010, Yeovil College's Da Vinci restaurant will be holding a Burns Night event, where members of the public can enjoy a traditional four-course meal for just £12.95.

This is the third consecutive year that the event has taken place, but the first time that it has been held on Burns Night itself.

The menu includes traditional favourites such as haddies, cock-a-leekie soup and of course haggis, served with champit tatties, bashed neeps and a creamy whisky and mustard sauce. All of the food is sourced locally from good quality providers.

All of the food and service staff on the night will be Level 2 and Level 3 Hospitality students, many of whom work in local restaurants to hone the skills learnt at Yeovil College. The students will be supported by members of the College lecturing staff.

Level 3 Hospitality Supervision & Leadership student Kelly Score (17) of Yeovil was in charge of planning the event. She said *"We're hosting a Burns night again this year to celebrate all things Scottish as is the tradition this time of the year. With our lecturer being Scottish, it is even more important to embrace this time of celebration! I was a part of last year's celebrations and everyone had a really good night, with guests particularly enjoying the Haggis."*

Scottish-born lecturer Steven Lowrie, who will be reciting the 'Address to the Haggis' in the traditional dialect, said *"It's absolutely fantastic to be able to celebrate Burns Night at the College again this year. We've already had more bookings for this event than in 2009. We're looking forward to welcoming a large number of guests to the Da Vinci and celebrating the life and work of the Bard of Scotland together."*
