

FIVE TOP REVISION TIPS!

1: GET ORGANISED!

Plan your revision early using a revision timetable. Break down your subjects into manageable topics or themes and allow yourself plenty of time to cover them all.

2: GET CREATIVE!

Find a revision style that works for you. Try using mind maps or big sheets of paper and coloured pens to break down, identify and link key themes and ideas.

3: LOOK AFTER YOURSELF


You're not superhuman - make sure that you take regular revision breaks. This gives you time to absorb what you've just learned. Get plenty of sleep, eat healthily and relax.

4: GET HELP!

If you feel things are getting on top of you, speak to a teacher, parent/carer or a member of the Student Support team at the College. They're there to help.

5: LOOK AHEAD

Once an exam is over, try not to think about it anymore. Focus on what you need to do next and get ready to go for it!
